

"We were attracted to this project for its distinct location and wanted to design a unique building that would make a lasting impression on this world-famous street and our city's skyline," adds Brown.

Featuring architecture by Diamond Schmitt Architects and interiors designed by Cecconi Simone, Whitehaus will boast an architecturally-striking, all white exterior. The 29-storey tower will feature 358 residences, ranging in size from 377 sq. ft. to 1,140 sq. ft., priced from \$261,900. Suites are available in a variety of one- to two-bedroomplus-den floorplans, and an exclusive selection of townhomes will soon be released.

To complement the canvaslike exterior. Cecconi Simone has designed the Whitehaus interiors to include vibrant splashes of colour. Boasting nine-ft. ceilings and floor-to-ceiling windows with spectacular views of the city, suites will feature spacious balconies and in-suite stacked washer and dryer. Contemporary kitchens will include custom-designed cabinetry by Cecconi Simone, quartz countertops, tile backsplash, and state-of-the-art





European-style kitchen appliances, including a stainless steel stove and microwave, a fully-integrated fridge and dishwasher, as well as a stainless steel undermount sink.

Whitehaus residents will have access to a wealth of amenities on the first floor including a private residents' lounge connected to an exterior gathering space, and a dog washing spa for residents with pets. The third floor will feature amenities that speak to personal expression, creativity and lifestyle, such as a fitness centre, event kitchen, a multipurpose, creative artist studio and a ping pong lounge that opens to an expansive outdoor area that includes a dog run.

"Once built, a condominium is very much a reflection of the people who live there, and we designed the amenities at Whitehaus to allow residents the freedom to express themselves and live the way they want to live," says Brown. "Beyond

the amazing amenities at home, Whitehaus is also located in the heart of a vibrant and lively neighbourhood that will complement residents' lifestyle, no matter what their interests are."
